Thyatira—A Church Where Jezebel Lives

¹Revelation 1:14,15 His head and His hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes were like a flame of fire; and His feet were like fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace, and His voice as the sound of many waters.

Rev. 2:19 I know your works, and love, and ¹service, and ²faith and your patience, (and your works; the last are ³more than the first).

¹Matthew 20:28 Even as the Son of Man came not to be ministered to, but to minister, and to give His life a ransom for many.

²Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

³2 Peter 3:18 But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be glory both now and forever. Amen.

Rev. 2:20 Nevertheless I have a few things against you, because you ¹tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, to teach and seduce My servants to commit fornication and to eat things sacrificed to idols.

¹1 Kings 16:31 And it came to pass, as if it had been a light thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the

son of Nebat, that he took as wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal, king of the Sidonians; and he went and served Baal and worshiped him.

¹Exodus 34:15 Lest you make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land, and they play the harlot after their gods, and sacrifice to their gods, and one call you and you eat of his sacrifice,

Rev. 2:21 And I gave her time to repent of her fornication, and she did not repent.

Rev. 2:22 Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and those who commit ¹adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of their deeds.

¹Galatians 5:19 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these: Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,

¹Hebrews 13:4 Marriage is honorable in all, and the bed undefiled: but fornicators and adulterers God will judge.

¹Exodus 20:14 You shall not commit adultery.

Rev. 2:23 And I will kill her children with death. And all the churches will know that I am He who ¹ searches the minds and hearts; and I will give to each one of you according to your works.

¹Jeremiah 11:20 But, O LORD of hosts, You judge righteously, You try the mind and the heart, let me see Your vengeance on them, for to You I have revealed

Rev. 3:2 Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die, for I have not found your works perfect before God.

Rev. 3:3 Remember therefore how you have received and heard, and hold fast and ¹repent. Therefore if you will not watch, I will come upon you as a ²thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you.

¹Luke 13:3,5 I tell you, no; but, unless you repent, you will all likewise perish."

²1 Thessalonians 5:2 For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night.

²1 Thessalonians 5:4 But you, brethren, are not in darkness, that this Day should overtake you as a thief,

²2 Peter 3:10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; the earth and also the works that are in it will be burned up.

And the world is passing away, and the lust of it, but he who does the will of God abides forever.

²Jude 1:23 And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire, hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

³Revelation 4:4 And around the throne were twenty-four seats, and upon the seats I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white raiment, and they had on their heads crowns of gold.

³Revelation 7:9 After this I beheld, and lo, a great multitude, which no one could number, of all nations and kindred and people and tongues standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palm branches in their hands.

³1. Iohn 1:7 But if we walk in the light as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin.

Philadelphia—A Church With Faithfulness

²Revelation 3:14 And to the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write: These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God.

³Matthew 28:18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All power is given to Me in heaven and on earth."

³Revelation 1:18 I am He who lives, and was dead, and, behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of Hades and Death.

³Isaiah 22:22 And the key of the house of David I will lay on his shoulder; so he shall open, and no one shall shut; and he shall shut, and no one shall open.

Laodicea—A Church That Is Sickening

¹Colossians 4:13 For I bear him record, that he has a great zeal for you, and those who are in Laodicea and those in Hierapolis.

²2 Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God by us.

³Revelation 1:5 And from Jesus Christ, who is the

faithful witness, the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us, and washed us from our sins in His own blood.

³Revelation 19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.

⁴Colossians 1:15 Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:

Rev. 3:15 I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. ¹I would that you were cold or hot.

¹Matthew 12:30 He who is not with Me, is against Me, and he who gathers not with Me scatters abroad.

Rev. 3:16 So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will spew you out of My mouth.

Rev. 3:17 Because you say, "I am ¹rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing," and you do not know that you are ²wretched and miserable and poor and ³blind and naked.

¹Hosea 12:8 And Ephraim said, "Yet I have become rich, I have found wealth for myself; in all my labors they shall find no iniquity in me that is sin"

¹1 Timothy 6:17 Charge those who are rich in this world, not to be high-minded, nor to trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy;

¹Luke 12:19 And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have many goods laid up for many years; take your ease, eat, drink, and be merry."

²Romans 7:24 O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from the body of this death?

³2 Peter 1:9 But he who lacks these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and has forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

Rev. 3:18 I counsel you to buy from Me gold tried in the fire, that you may be ¹rich; and white raiment, that you may be ²clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see.

¹Matthew 6:19-21 Lay not up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust does corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal; but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal. ¹1 Timothy 5:20 Those who sin, rebuke before all, that the others also may fear.

¹Titus 1:13 This witness is true. Therefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith,

²Job 5:17 Behold, happy is the man whom God corrects; therefore do not despise the chastening of the Almighty:

²Hebrews 12:5-11 And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to children, "My son, do not despise the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when you are rebuked by Him; for whom the Lord loves He chastens, and scourge every son whom He receives. If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father does not chasten? But if you are without chastisement, of which all are partakers, then you are illegitimate, and not sons. Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh who corrected us, and we gave them reverence. Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of spirits and live? For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but He for our profit, that we might be partakers of His holiness. Now no chastening for the present seems to be joyful, but grievous; nevertheless afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who are exercised by it.

Rev. 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice, and 1 opens the door, I will come in to him and will 2 dine with him, and he with Me.

¹Hebrews 6:4-6 For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Spirit, and have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, if they shall fall away, to renew them again to repentance, since they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put Him to an open shame.

¹Hebrews 10:26-29 For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, but a certain fearful looking for of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries. He who despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses. Of how much severe punishment do you suppose, will be thought worthy who has trodden under foot the Son

of God, and has counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified an unholy thing, and has done despite to the Spirit of grace?

¹Luke 13:3,5 I tell you, no; but, unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.

¹Acts 8:22 Repent therefore of this your wickedness, and pray God if perhaps the thought of your heart may be forgiven you.
