PAPHOS ISLAND OF CYPRUS	13:6-12	* Western end of Island in Med. Sea	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. City of Venus, noted for low morals 2. Elymas, enemy sorcerer to Christianity 3. Sergius Paulus called for Barnabas & Saul 4. Elymas hindered, Saul struck him blind 5. Saul's name changed to Paul 6. Sergius Paulus astonished and believed
PERGA OF PAMPHYLIA	13:13	* 150 miles NE of Cyprus 7-1/2 miles Cestris R.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Capital of Pamphylia, home of goddess Leto 2. Paul now takes the lead 3. Direction of Paul's native land 4. No preaching details recorded here 5. John Mark turned back here

ANTIOCH IN PISIDIA	13:14-52	*Foot of Tarus Mountains in Asia Minor	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 100 miles of dangerous trails from Perga to this city 2. Entered synagogue, first recorded sermon by the Apostle Paul 3. Sermon began with history, led to Christ 4. Invited to preach on the next Sabbath 5. Almost all the city came--stirred jealousy 6. Jewish leaders began persecution 7. Paul turned to mission of Gentiles (v. 47)
ICONIUM	13:51- 14:1-6	Foot of Tarus Mt. 120 miles from Med. Sea Asia Minor	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Capital of Lyconia in Asia Minor, a very rich city 2. Great multitudes of Jews & Gentiles believed 3. Signs performed, they spoke boldly 4. Unbelieving Jews threatened stoning them
LYSTRA	14:6-20	Short distance South of Iconium 30 miles from Lystra Asia Minor	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A city controled by Rome, with many Heathen worshipers 2. A lame man is healed 3. Heathens thought their gods did the miracle 4. Tried to worship Paul as Mercurius and Barnabas as Jupiter 5. Jews stirred, then a stoning for Paul 6. Left for dead, but got up and moved on
DERBE	14:6 14:20-21	30 miles from Lystra Asia Minor	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Paul is now only 110 miles from Tarsus 2. Preaches the Gospel, teaching many 3. Returns to home by back-tracking 4. This is home land of Timothy

SYRIA AND CILICIA	15:41	Mainland north & west of Antioch	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Near the coast line of the Med. Sea 2. Traveled through Paul's home land 3. Stepping stones to greater works 4. The Lord is guiding them to a new work
DERBE AND LYSTRA	16:1-5	Asia Minor	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Controled by Rome--Heathen worshipers 2. Chose Timothy for a helper 3. Had him circumcised to avoid Jews 4. Churches established in faith 5. Churches increased in number daily

TROAS	16:8-10	Eastern shore of the Aegean Sea	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Four miles from ancient Troy of literature 2. Homer's setting 3. Paul felt Gospel above historical greatness 4. Vision of a man in Macedonia 5. Luke joins the work here 6. Boarded a ship for Europe

NEAPOLIS	16:11	Southwest of Philippi	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. On northeastern shore of Aegean Sea 2. First landing on European soil 3. No preaching is mentioned
PHILIPPI	16:12-40	Macedonia, 10 miles inland	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Chief city of Macedonia 2. Near a chain of mountains 1600 feet high 3. Contained Gangites River & gold--silver mines 4. No reception for the missionaries 5. Converted Lydia & household at river 6. Healed damsel with spirit of divination 7. Paul and company beaten, thrown in prison 8. Earthquake, Jailor and house converted 9. Rulers ushered Paul & workers out town
AMPHI-POLIS	17:1	33 miles SW of Philippi	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A Roman military station 2. In river bend--had a Jewish synagogue 3. Paul worked larger places--they fanned out 4. Passed on through this city
APOLLON-IA	17:1	30 miles SW Amphipolis	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Town of trade, named from Apollo god 2. No mission work mentioned 3. Probably to be reached from Thessalonica 4. A travel marker to follow Paul
THESSALONICA	17:1-10	Second part of Macedonia Seaport City	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. First named Therme, located on the road Via Egnatia 2. Preached 3 Sabbaths on Gospel facts 3. Some Jews, great multitudes of Greeks & more than a few chief women believed 4. Established a congregation here 5. Rulers captured Jason & some brethren 6. Missionaries accused, turning world upside down. 7. Accused speaking against Caesar 8. Became advisable to leave by night

BEREA	17:10-14	50 miles SW of Thessalonica	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. On eastern slope of Olympian range 2. A city of gardens and fountains 3. Paul preached in synagogue--many believed 4. Timothy joined the company 5. Thessalonian Jews came to stir trouble 6. Bereans noble for searching scriptures 7. Paul left Silas & Timothy behind as he went on, with brethren, to Athens
ATHENS	17:15-34	Southeastern part of Greece	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Capital of Attica, university of learning 2. False gods and idols on every hand 3. Teachers, philosophers, schools of all types represented 4. Paul's famous address (Acts 17:22-31) 5. Paul made them aware of Jehovah & Christ 6. Politely rejected him--certain men and women believed 7. Planted word--won't return void!
CORINTH	18:1-18	50 miles West of Athens	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Located on an isthmus, a short-cut from peninsula to mainland trade 2. Temple of Venus--1,000 harlots in temple 3. Paul wrote of heathens from here (Rom. 1:21-32) 4. Aquilla & Priscilla, tentmakers too, found 5. Turned from Jews--entered house of Justus 6. Crispus & many Corinthians converted 7. God appeared to Paul, gave assurance 8. Preached at this place 18 months
CENCHREA	18:18	9 miles East of Corinth A harbor town	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Very little information on this stop 2. A church now or later begun (Rom. 16:1) 3. Home of Phebe 4. Here Paul took a vow--shaved his head
EPHESUS	18:19-21	Asia, due east of Cenchrea	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. City of trade and art 2. Temple of Diana, had many silversmiths 3. Left Priscilla & Aquila here 4. Paul must rush on to keep Jerusalem feast 5. Planned to return on next trip 6. Taught in synagogue before departure

PLACE	ACTS	LOCATED	FACTS AND HAPPENINGS
CAESAREA	18:22	70 miles north of Jerusalem	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Three months sailing time from Ephesus 2. No preaching mentioned at this stop 3. Closest place to land for Jerusalem 4. Attended the feast in Jerusalem 5. Then returned back to Antioch of Syria
ANTIOCH OF SYRIA	18:22-23	300 miles north of Jerusalem Palestine	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Third city in greatness, 200,000 pop., A Greek city 2. Has had a truly prosperous journey

Paul leaves home base for the last time 3. Probably reported on the work in Europe 4. Must have reported welfare of Jerusalem 5. Begins another Journey to preach word
GALATIA AND PHRYGIA	18:23	Asia Minor	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. At one time District Province, land of the Gauls 2. Covered the region of his birth 3. On his way back to Ephesus 4. Strengthening all the disciples 5. Wanted to keep Christians saved
EPHESUS	18:24-28 19:1-20	Asia, due east of Cenchrea	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. City of trade and art with temple of Diana 2. Many silversmiths in this city 3. Apollos taught further by Priscilla & Aquila 4. Paul re-baptized some that knew not of the Holy Spirit 5. Began in the synagogue, then moved to the school of Tyrannus 6. Paul taught--performed miracles 2yrs. & 3 months 7. 7 sons of Sceva tried evil spirit--failed 8. Demetrius, silversmith stirred city, but Town Clerk helped settle them down 9. Great success accomplished at this stop
GREECE	20:2-3	West of Asia across the Aegean Sea	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Looked over previous work 2. Spent three months working here 3. Wrote Roman letter here (Rom. 15:25-16:1) 4. On his way to Asia, 7 men went along

PLACE	ACTS	LOCATED	FACTS AND HAPPENINGS
PHILIPPI	20:6	Macedonia, 10 miles inland	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Joined again by Luke 2. This time forward, Luke speaks as an eye witness 3. Remains here until after unleaven bread 4. Left for Troas
TROAS	20:5-13	Eastern shore Aegean Sea	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Spent 7 days preaching and teaching 2. Example given as to time of taking Lord's Supper 3. Eutychus fell asleep, died, but Paul raised him to life again
ASSOS	20:13-14	In Mysia	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Seaport town near Troas 2. Just a place mentioned to mark route 3. No preaching is mentioned by Luke
MITYLENE	20:4	Island in Aegean Sea	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 12 miles to Asia Minor, Capital Lesbos, and birthplace of poets 2. Just spent night, no spiritual work recorded.
CHIOS	20:15	Island in Aegean Sea	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 32 miles long, 8 to 18 miles wide 2. Just passed by, but didn't stop
SAMOS	20:15	Off the coast of Asia Minor	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Eighty miles in circumference 2. Just arrived at this Island, says Luke 3. Possibly did not tarry here
TRO-GYLLIUM	20:15	Western coast of Asia Minor	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A point of land projected from coast line 2. Just spent the night 3. Today, east of the point is a place called St. Paul's Port

MILETUS	20:15-36	36 miles south of Ephesus	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 70 miles to Ephesus by land, and had a temple of Apollo 2. Paul asked Ephesian elders to meet him 3. Gave them a touching farewell address 4. Reminded them of responsibilities as elders 5. Paul knew flock in danger of wolves 6. Knelt & prayed, then kissed their necks 7. Left knowing see face no more
COOS	21:1	Little Island in Aegean Sea	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Twenty one miles long, six miles wide 2. Made a straight course to Coos 3. Just an overnight stop--no preaching
