

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Section 1

Introduction of The Lord's Supper

The Jord's Supper

What a blessing it is for Christians to come together on Sunday, the Lord's Day, to remember the death of Jesus. What a great honor God has bestowed upon the men who are chosen to take the lead in giving thanks and serving the Lord's Supper. It is a time of communion—a time when all Christians, with purpose in their hearts, remember the body and blood of Jesus in fellowship.

When David wrote that man is fearfully and wonderfully made (**Psalm 139:14**), he must have had in mind (along with other things) our ability to remember. Even though many centuries have come and gone, each Sunday we can travel back in time to the scenes of Calvary.

The memorial that Jesus chose is a perpetual one. If He had chosen a physical statue or a huge image of the cross as objects for remembrance, time would have defaced these, and they would have disappeared. However, in all generations until the Lord returns, the unleavened bread and the fruit of the vine are new and fresh reminders each Lord's day of the body and blood of Jesus (1 Corinthians 11:24-26). O how we can see God's wisdom in this special memorial supper!

It is the sincere belief of this author that the men in the church have done a great job in presiding at the Lord's table. Many have chosen such beautiful words as they have given thanks and blessed the bread and cup. However, in all kindness, some have not made an effort to grow and improve their prayers. Others have simply memorized a few lines and repeated them over the years. This is not intended as criticism, but rather as a challenge to improve. Although there are certain guidelines to follow from the New Testament record, there are various approaches in our prayers that can help us draw closer to the Father as we remember His Son.

The examples of prayers given in the following section of this book are designed to motivate your thinking. Hopefully you will use them to kindle your thinking as you seek to grow spiritually in your leadership and prayers. Even though you may not choose to memorize them, they can still serve to stimulate your thinking.

Each week that you are chosen to serve, you might wish to select a particular prayer in this series to help you pray in a more spiritual way.

An effort has been made to design these prayers from the pattern and examples given by Jesus when He instituted the Lord's Supper. Please study closely the following accounts of this all important event selected from my "Self-Teaching New Testament" published by Quality Publications.

MATTHEW'S ACCOUNT

Matt. 26:26 And [on the same night in which He was betrayed, 1 Cor. 11:23] as they were eating, [I desired to eat the Passover with you before I suffer, Lk. 22:15] Jesus took [unleavened] bread, and blessed it, [gave thanks, 1 Cor. 11:24] and broke it, and gave it to the disciples, [the twelve apostles, Lk. 22:14] and said, "Take, eat; this is My body" [which is given (broken) for you; do this in remembrance of Me, Lk. 22:19; 1 Cor. 11:24;—was not His literal body, but represented His body, because His body was present when He gave thanks].

Matt. 26:27 And He took the cup, [fruit of the vine, Lk. 22:18;-

after supper, Lk. 22:20] and gave thanks, [blessed it, vs. 26] and gave it to them, [the disciples] saying, [divide it among yourselves, Lk. 22:17] "Drink from it, [the contents, not the container, that which represented His blood] all of you [and they all drank of it, Mk. 14:23].

Matt. 26:28 For this is My blood [figuratively so, in the same way He had used figurative language when He taught, the field is the world, good seed are the children of the kingdom, etc., Mt. 13:38,39] of the new testament, [covenant, Jer. 31:31; Heb. 8:8-13] which is shed for many [for you, Lk. 22:20] for the remission [forgiveness, Acts 2:38] of sins [the main purpose of the cross—to make forgiveness of sins possible—all other purposes are secondary—the bread and fruit of the vine were followed with the words, 'Do this in remembrance of Me,' 1 Cor 11:24].

MARK'S ACCOUNT

Mark 14:22 And [on the same night in which He was betrayed, 1 Cor. 11:23] as they ate, [I desired to eat the Passover with you before I suffer, Lk. 22:15] Jesus took [unleavened] bread, and blessed, [gave thanks, 1 Cor. 11:24] and broke it, and gave it to them, [the twelve apostles, Lk. 22:14] and said, "Take, eat: this is My body" [which is given (broken) for you; do this in remembrance of Me, Lk. 22:1; 1 Cor. 11:24;—was not His literal body, but represented His body, because His body was present when He gave thanks].

Mark 14:23 And He took the cup, [fruit of the vine, Lk. 22:18; after supper, Lk. 22:20] and when He had given thanks, [blessed it, Mt. 26:26] He gave it to them, [divide it among yourselves, Lk. 22:17] and they all drank of it [the contents, not the container, that which represented His blood].

Mark 14:24 And He said to them, "This is My blood [figuratively so, in the same way He had used figurative language when He taught, the field is the world, good seed are the children of the kingdom, etc., Mt. 13:38,39] of the new testament, [covenant, Jer. 31:31; Heb. 8:8-13] which is shed for many [for the remission of sins, Mt. 26:28; Acts 2:38;—for you, Lk. 22:20].

LUKE'S ACCOUNT

Luke 22:14 And when the hour had come, [the evening, Mt. 26:20] He sat down, and the twelve apostles with Him [first foretold what Judas would do, Mt. 26:21-25].

Luke 22:15 And [on the same night in which He was betrayed, 1 Cor. 11:23] He said to them, "I have earnestly desired to eat this Passover with you before I suffer;

Luke 22:16 for I say to you, I will no longer eat of it, until it is fulfilled [even though Jesus returned to His Father, He communed with His disciples each time they partook of the Lord's Supper] in the kingdom of God" [He would purchase His church, kingdom, Mt. 16:18, with His blood, Acts 20:28].

Luke 22:17 And He took the cup, [fruit of the vine, vs. 18] and gave thanks, [blessed it, Mt. 26:26] and said, "Take this, and divide it among yourselves; [drink from it, Mt. 26:27;—the contents of the container].

Luke 22:18 for I say to you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, [until that day I drink it new with you, Mt. 26:29] until the kingdom of God comes" [even though Jesus returned to His Father, He communed with His disciples each time they partook of the Lord's Supper].

Luke 22:19 And He took [unleavened] bread, and gave thanks, [blessed it, Mt. 26:26] and broke it, and gave to them, [the twelve apostles, vs. 14] saying, "This is My body [1 Cor. 11:24;—was not His literal body, but represented His body, because His body was present when He gave thanks] which is given for you; this do in remembrance of Me."

Luke 22:20 Likewise also He took the cup [fruit of the vine, vs. 18] after supper, [after they had eaten] saying, "This cup is the new testament [covenant] in My blood, which is shed for you [for many for the remission of sins, Mt. 26:28;—the main purpose of the cross—to make forgiveness of sins possible—all other purposes are second-ary—the bread and fruit of the vine were followed with the words, 'Do this in remembrance of Me,' 1 Cor 11:24].

PAUL'S ACCOUNT

1 Cor. 11:23 For I have received of the Lord that which I also delivered to you; [Paul had taught them the truth earlier about the Lord's Supper] that the Lord Jesus the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; [unleavened, Mt. 26:26].

1 Cor. 11:24 and when He had given thanks, [blessedit, Mk. 14:22] He broke it and said, "Take, eat; this is My body, [where He bore our sins on the tree, 1 Pet. 2:24] which is broken [on the cross] for you; do this in remembrance of Me" [a memorial].

1 Cor. 11:25 After the same manner [as the bread—He gave thanks, vs. 24; Mk. 14:23] He also took the cup, [the fruit of the vine, Mt. 26:29] when He had supped, [after supper] saying, "This cup is the new testament [covenant] in My blood [shed for many for the remission of sins, Mt. 26:28]. This do, as often as you drink it, [the New Testament example is on Sunday, the first day of the week, Acts 20:7] in remembrance of Me" [the Lord's Supper is a very important memorial].

1 Cor. 11:26 For as often as you eat this [unleavened, Mt. 26:17,26] bread, [to remember His body, vs. 24] and drink this cup, [the fruit of the vine, Mt. 26:29, to remember His blood, vs. 25] you do show [proclaim] the Lord's death until He comes [this memorial was designed to last until the Lord returns to receive His own, John 14:3].

Must Partake in a Worthy Manner

1 Cor. 11:27 Therefore whoever eats this [unleavened, Mt. 26:26] bread, or drinks this cup [the fruit of the vine, Mt. 26:29, to remember His blood, vs. 25] of the Lord, unworthily, [in an unworthy or disorderly manner that would keep them from properly remembering the death of Jesus] shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord [the Corinthians were guilty of this sin when they turned the Lord's Supper into a drunken feast of gluttony and selfishness, vss. 17-22;—this should be a warning to all Christians in every generation].

1 Cor. 11:28 But let a man examine himself, [to make sure he is remembering properly the body and blood of Jesus, cf. 2 Cor. 13:5]

and so let him eat of that [unleavened, Mt. 26:17,26] bread, and drink of that cup [the fruit of the vine, Mt. 26:29, to remember His blood, vs. 25:—to make sure one is partaking in a worthy manner, vs. 27].

1 Cor. 11:29 For he who eats and drinks unworthily, [in an unworthy manner] eats and drinks damnation [judgment] to himself, not discerning the Lord's body [does not properly keep this God-given memorial].

1 Cor. 11:30 For this reason [failing to properly discern the Lord's body] **many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep** [either Paul was speaking metaphorically or literally—if metaphorically, he is speaking of spiritual weakness, illness, and death—if literally, physically many were weak, sick, and had fallen asleep in death].

From these verses you will notice the following guidelines for offering thanks at the Lord's Table:

- A. He began with the bread
- **B.** He blessed the bread
- **C.** He gave thanks for the cup
- **D**.The purpose of each one
 - was in remembrance of Jesus.

RUN A TEST

Each man who offers thanks at the Lord's table should analyze his prayers to make sure all Scriptural requirements are included. Based on the model prayer, the instituting of the Lord's Supper, and other New Testament teaching on prayer, the following pattern should be followed:

1. Address The Father

Jesus taught His disciples to direct their prayer to:

"Our Father in heaven" (Matthew 6:9). Therefore, when giving thanks for the bread and cup representing the body and blood of Jesus, speak to the Father.

When Jesus gave thanks for the bread and cup, nothing infers that He gave thanks to Himself. When we offer thanks, we are remembering the body and blood of Jesus, but expressing thanks to our Father in heaven.

2. Address The Father With Honor

Referring back to the model prayer, after addressing the Father in heaven, Jesus added, "**Hallowed be Your name**" (Matthew 6:9). In our prayers at the Lord's table, there are many expressions that can be used to honor Him. However, there are times when we may want to honor Him by using the words, "Dear Father," "Precious Father," "Dear Lord," "Holy Father," and others. Addressing the Father with honor is an important part of worship.

3. Confine Prayers To The Cross

When offering thanks for the Lord's Supper, it is not the proper time to pray a general prayer. Other times have been set aside for this. Have you ever heard prayers before serving the bread and the fruit of the vine where the death of Jesus was hardly mentioned? This is not the way it should be, because the whole occasion centers around the death of Jesus.

We do not need ANYTHING, even other important spiritual things, to take our minds away from Calvary. Paul quoted Jesus as saying, after both the bread and cup were blessed, **"This do in remembrance of me. For as** often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes" (1 Corinthians 11:24-26).

4. Always Give Thanks or Bless the Bread And the Cup

It is at this point (more than any other) that prayers around the Lord's table leave the New Testament pattern. In all the examples where Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper, He either **blessed** or **gave thanks** for the bread and the cup.

"And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, BLESSED IT and broke it" (Matthew 26:26).

"Then He took the cup, and GAVE THANKS" (Matthew 26:27).

"And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, BLESSED IT and broke it" (Mark 14:22).

"Then He took the cup, and when He had GIVEN THANKS He gave it to them" (Mark 14:23).

"Then He took the cup, and GAVE THANKS, and said, 'Take this and divide it among yourselves" (Luke 22:19).

"That the Lord Jesus on the same night in which He was betrayed took bread; and when He had GIVEN THANKS, He broke it and said" (1 Corinthians 11:23,24).

"In the same manner He also took the cup" (1

Corinthians 11:25).

Since Jesus made a special effort to **give thanks** or to **bless** the bread and cup, shouldn't we do the same?

5. Always Offer Thanks In Jesus' Name

Finally, just as it is important to begin our thanks addressed to the Father, it is likewise important to close it by offering it in the name of Jesus.

Christians should always remember that we have only one mediator between ourselves and the Father— "the Man Christ Jesus" (1 Timothy 2:5). When we remember the body and blood of Jesus the way that Jesus commanded, the Father is pleased.

Jesus was an obedient Son when He died on the cross. "....He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross" (Philippians 2:8). Therefore, the Father is pleased when we remember His Son and give thanks through His name.

Jesus made the promise while on earth, "And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it" (John 14:13,14).

It is the prayer of this writer that you have the desire in your heart to improve your prayers and service at the Lord's table.

Therefore, with this thought in your mind, would you consider prayerfully the examples in the following Sections designed to encourage you to spiritual growth.

Section 2 Prayers For The Bread

Dear Father In Heaven

We thank you for the honor and privilege of remembering Your Son's body. Would You bless this bread representing His body and all who remember according to Your will.

In Jesus' name. Amen.

Prayer # 2

Our Loving Father

We lift up our hearts in thanks for this bread that Jesus said is His body. May we remember His body as He intended for us to remember.

In Jesus' Holy name. Amen.

Prayer # 3

Our Blessed Father

We have gathered here in worship now to remember Jesus and the body that He offered. Please accept our thanks for this bread to be eaten in memory of His body.

In His name we pray. Amen.

Holy Father In Heaven

On this Your day we come to remember Your Son's body offered in sacrifice at Calvary. Would You bless this bread?

In the name of Jesus. Amen.

Prayer # 5

Dear Lord and Father

As we come together, we pray in unity. We offer You thanks for this bread to be eaten in memory of the body of Christ. We pray that You will be pleased as we remember.

In Your Son's name we pray. Amen.

Prayer # 6

Our Father in Heaven

Hallowed be Your name, the name of Jesus, and the power of the Holy Spirit. Father, would You bless this bread as Jesus blessed it in the long ago in remembrance of His body?

Our Precious Father

We know that You love us because You gave Your Son in death. Thank You for this precious gift. And now we thank You for this bread representing His body broken on the cross.

In Jesus' name. Amen.

Prayer # 8

Dear Lord

We approach Your throne in thanksgiving for this bread that Jesus said to eat in memory of His body. Please help us now to center our minds on His sacrifice for our sins.

In the Precious name of Jesus we pray. Amen.

Prayer # 9

Holy Father in Heaven

We approach You with sadness and joy. Sad for the pain that You and Your Son endured at the cross for our sins. Yet, joyful for the love and forgiveness offered. Would You bless this bread as we remember His body?

In His Holy name we give thanks. Amen.

Dear Father

Once again You have honored us to see another Lord's Day and to remember our Savior, Jesus. Help us now as our minds travel back over the centuries to the cross. Father, bless this bread as the remembrance of the body of Jesus.

In Jesus' name we offer this thanks. Amen.

Prayer # 11

Merciful Father

As we offer You thanks for this bread representing Your Son's body, we thank You for this gift of love.

In Jesus' name. Amen.

Prayer # 12

Our Father In Heaven

We come together in loving memory of the death of Jesus on the cruel cross. We honor You and Your Son Jesus for allowing us to be among the friends for whom He laid down His life. Father, please bless this bread to remember His body.

Dear Father In Heaven

Thank You for Your Son and Calvary. As we have gathered to worship, we thank You for this bread that Jesus said, "Take eat, this is My body." Help us to remember His body as He intended when He broke the bread and gave to His disciples.

In Jesus' name. Amen.

Prayer # 14

Precious Father In Heaven

After a week filled with many physical activities, it is so refreshing to our souls to remember, as Your children, the sacrifice of Jesus. Our Father, we offer You thanks for this bread to remember His body offered in love.

In Jesus Holy name. Amen.

Prayer # 15

Dear Lord

Thank You for Jesus and His body offered in agony and love for our sins. Would You bless this bread to the remembrance of that body that was nailed for us at sad Calvary.

Our Father

Lest we forget sad Calvary with all of His pain and agony, would You bless this bread instituted by Jesus to remember His holy gift—given in love and sacrifice. Father, please help us now to think about His body and death as we partake.

In Jesus' name. Amen.

Prayer # 17

Loving Father

We have assembled here as Christians to honor and remember the death of Jesus. We long to eat this bread in a worthy manner. Our Father, we give you thanks for this bread—His body—as one of the ways given by Jesus to show forth His death. Please help us to be pleasing as we partake.

In Jesus' name. Amen.

Prayer # 18

In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

Prayer # 20

We know that many centuries have passed since Jesus sacrificed His life on the cross. But we pray, Father, that as we eat this bread it will bring the offering of His body fresh to our minds. Father, would You bless this bread for the purpose of remembering His body.

In Jesus' name. Amen.

Prayer # 29

Dear Father

Please bless this bread, and may we partake of it in a worthy manner. Help us now to think of Jesus and His body given in our stead. May this be spiritually acceptable in Your sight.

In Jesus' name. Amen.

Prayer # 30

Precious Father

Thank You for giving us Jesus and Calvary. We know that without this sacrifice, we would be lost forever. We give You thanks for this bread that Jesus called His body. Father, be with us as we remember.

In the name of Jesus we pray. Amen.

When Jesus took the bread and blessed it, He opened for us a beautiful memorial to remember. Would You bless this bread and be with us, as in our minds, we return to the cross? Help us, by the eye of faith, see His body being offered so that we can choose eternal life.

In His name. Amen.

Prayer # 32

Precious Father

As we have gathered together on this first day of the week to break bread, would You bless this bread representing Christ's body. Please help each of us to examine himself and herself so that we may partake in a worthy manner.

We ask this in the name of Jesus. Amen.

Prayer # 33

Loving Father

We thank You for creating us with the power to remember. Our Father, we thank You for this bread divinely chosen to help us remember the crucified body of Jesus. Would You guide our memories to be pure and pleasing to You.

Our Lord and Father

It is with faith and hope that we approach this communion. As we eat this unleavened bread to remember Christ's broken body, give us a renewed hope of forgiveness of sins and eternal life. Father, please bless this bread.

In Jesus's name. Amen.

Prayer # 35

Dear Lord

Thank You for the privilege of worship, and especially now for being able to remember the death of Jesus. Please bless this bread to the remembrance of the body of Your Son Jesus.

In the name of Christ our Lord we pray. Amen.

Prayer # 36

Our Father in Heaven-Hallowed be Your name.

We thank You for honoring us with another Lord's Day upon this earth, and for this time of worship. We thank You Father for this bread set forth by Jesus to remember His body offered for our sins. Help us now as we remember Him.

Loving Father

As we gather around this table with the divine purpose of remembering the sacrificial death of Your Son, we plead for Your divine guidance. Would You bless this bread to remember the body of Jesus given on Golgotha to give us hope of eternal life.

On this beautiful Spring Lord's Day, we come now to worship and remember the death of Jesus. By remembering His death, we also thank You for His resurrection, and the hope we have of being resurrected to life. Thank You Father for this bread representing His body on the cross.

In Jesus' name. Amen.

Prayer # 41

Dear Lord

As the seasons of the year change, we are reminded of how fast this life is passing. And Father, help us to realize the importance of things spiritual. Thank You for this bread and body of Jesus offered to give us eternal life. May we take this bread in remembrance of Him.

Prayer # 42

We now approach Your throne of grace in thanksgiving for the bread to remember the body of Christ. Please Father, help us to remember in an acceptable way. Thank You for everything.
